4. In-kind services from the City of Brampton Update

- The report will go back to Council next week for final approval.

5. Marketing

- Social media promotion began with a "Save the Date" post and has received positive reception.
- One advertisement in the Brampton Guardian will be going out close to July.
- Other tactics include radio advertising, posters, and A-frames.
- Targeted audience for advertising ranges from ages 25-65 in Brampton and surrounding Brampton areas. The Discover Downtown magazine also has a feature.
- Action point: arrange a separate marketing meeting on Classic Cars Celebration.

6. Saturday Celebrations on Main Street

- Three performers are scheduled from 2:30 to about 5:00 p.m., including:
 - Elvis/ Terry Chrism
 - o Frank Sinnatra
 - o Alicia doing Shania Twain
 - They may also be present in the parade if they wish.
- After 5 p.m., the School of Rock is taking mini bands since the stage is small and will be performing until 10 p.m.
- The BIA will ask members how long they want to stay if they participate and will allot different times to stay (i.e. until 5 p.m. or 10 p.m.).
 - Priority will be given to Main Street, then other BIA members, Farmers'
 Market vendors, and finally community groups such as Snapd.
 - Purpose is to have activity when the cars leave.
- Thursday night on Wellington Street is closed to have cars come in.
- The police car has been requested and S. Ching is meeting with them next week. The fire engine is not available.
