**INVESTIGATIONAL WORK  
MAIN AND QUEEN STREETS AND ADJACENT SIDE STREETS  
DOWNTOWN BRAMPTON**

The Region of Peel, in coordination with the City of Brampton, will be doing some survey work in your area in preparation for future infrastructure improvements in the downtown core.

This work will start in mid-July, and is expected to take about ten to twelve weeks. During this time, you may notice Region of Peel staff and contractors doing the following activities in your neighbourhood:

- Surveying your street.
- Marking the location of gas, hydro, cable, etc. on roads, driveways and lawns.
- Drilling small vacuum excavation holes to determine utility depths.

This work will take place in these areas:

- Queen Street – Mill Street South to Centre Street
- Main Street – Church Street to Wellington Street
- Chapel Street – Queen Street to Wellington Street
- Moore Crescent
- Mary Street – Queen Street to Moore Crescent
- Elizabeth Street – Queen Street to Wellington Street
- George Street – Queen Street to 50 meters south, and Nelson Street to Railroad Street
- Wellington Street – Main Street to James Street
- James Street
- Park Hill Court
- Vivian Lane
- Diplock Lane – Nelson Street to 60 meters south

There will be no impact to businesses, sidewalks or pedestrian traffic. Vehicle traffic will be maintained at all times. There will be intermittent disruptions to the availability of on-street parking. It is recommended that City of Brampton parking facilities, with one hour of free parking, be used during this time. These facilities are located on Diplock Lane, Theatre Lane, George Street South and John Street.
