
Display of Wares



We encourage retail businesses to capitalize on the City By-Law that allows retail businesses to display merchant summer decorations on the sidewalk in front of their stores. See below for all of the program guidelines, which was implemented by Brampton City Council on November 9, 2012 in order to:

- Improve the appearance and functionality of the downtown core by facilitating the installation of flower pots, planters, small patios where no alcohol is served, street furniture with tables and chairs, benches and other items
- To facilitate and allow display of private wares and services within the public right of way as part of the Downtown Revitalization and Beautification Program. Key issues to take in consideration when applying for the program:
 - \circ The display has to be of good quality and improve the appearance and functionality of the downtown core
 - The wares and displays have to be temporary in nature (the approval is for Mar. 1-Jan. 2), removable, non-intrusive, and not to impede the pedestrian circulation, snow removal and street cleaning
 - \circ A minimum clearance of 1100mm (44") is required, which is conditional to an on-site evaluation to permit barrier free accessibility for people with disabilities

In addition to this, the City of Brampton and the Downtown Brampton BIA have a special merchant flower Planter Program, whereby the City and the BIA will fund your business 50% of your floral/garden box supplies Through this process, 50% of your total expenditure up to \$150.00 will be covered by the BIA, which is a maximum of a \$75.00 rebate to beautify your front entrance way. Lab B


