- **Thursday, March 8 at 9 am to Monday, March 12 at 5 am**
  - Main Street North from Nelson Street West/Theatre Lane to Queen Street
  
- **Saturday, March 10 at 10 am to Sunday, March 11 at 11:59 pm**
  - Main Street South from Queen Street to Wellington Street
  - Queen Street from George Street to Chapel Street/Theatre Lane
  - John Street from Main Street South to Chapel Street, will be converted from a one-way to two-way street for the duration of the above closure

As always, the City of Brampton continues to put every effort into minimizing the impact of festivals on residents and businesses throughout the downtown. We hope that by notifying you of the road closure dates and locations in advance, you are able to plan for a safe and enjoyable event season.
