They try and get them off the

It takes about 26 approaches with the same individual to get them off the streets</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Telus sponsor medical office on wheels, which incorporate addiction workers, public nurses. They are coming to council in mid November with a proposal, see what the budget ask will be • Downtown presence , there will be a community hub with the Peel Regional Police • Process of getting homeless permanently housed • Since CIBC closed, there is an increase of bodies, taking over downtown core and Garden Square. Customers don't want to come in anymore • Landlord can give trespass property authority over to police, and they can help when a situation occurs and the landlord is not present • Community Liaison Cst. Brad Grozier deals with businesses to Trespass authority • More beat officers in the downtown in spring 2020 • Homeless keep getting dropping off in downtown Brampton • Report going to council November 14th
