

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If it is not a public safety issue, cannot ask the individuals to leave • Need to make sure that all individuals are being connected to resources offered by the Region of Peel • There is one individual who sleeps in McLaughlin Park and has a cart, that they push through the downtown • Another gentleman who approaches cars in downtown Brampton, and yesterday he was approaching cars in a wheelchair • The City of Brampton will distribute this information to Peel Outreach, and Peel Police about these individuals • Action: Follow up with the Parks department about the tree pruning in downtown Brampton • There was road repairs on Main St North, near RBC bank, employees reached out to the Region or Peel to fix a broken valve • There was a water main break at Brampton AMA, the Region and reached out to the property owners • The break is on the private property side, and is being fixed by the Region • Yvonne Yeung’s team from the City of Brampton gave an update on the downtown precinct plan, with the BIA, and members of New Brampton on a number of downtown Capital Projects • There is a meeting tomorrow to follow up on the discussion for the City of Brampton plans for the downtown • Need to keep an active downtown, while it is being dug up throughout construction • The City of Barrie just went through water main upgrades, they had a good marketing plan, businesses were informed, and had sidewalks open • Urban design is working on this lay out and informing the businesses • Action: After tomorrow’s New Brampton, BIA, and Precinct Plan meeting bring back a summary of information to the full Board of Director’s, and a meanwhile strategy for construction • Action: Reach out to the Barrie BIA , to see how they dealt with construction, work, patio strategy • The Barrie BIA has created a patio program, that has around 20-25 patios now in Downtown Barrie • Through the patio program, they have a young clientele visiting the downtown • Key continuing point is the number of times and years past that these strategies have been approached and not in place • Waiting for completion of EA, need to see matching timelines for start and completion of each of these projects, with water main, and LRT 	<p>S.
