1.	<p>Watermain Replacement Project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Region of Peel is planning on putting in an interim watermain either in July or October • The BIA has delegated to Council, suggesting to dig up the road to only dig it up once • The LRT debate keeps affecting the decision on the downtown • There was a motion that called for city staff to review what can be done with the construction and watermain work and come back in 90 days • The construction is going to be 18 months to a two year project • It does not make sense to dig up the roads multiple times throughout the next 10 years • The watermains must be fixed to avoid watermain breakage • S.Godefroy has had a number of businesses reach out with regards to the watermain construction work and concerns with a full closure • The Region of Peel has done a survey and a lot of businesses responses has been to do a full closure the results will be going to Council • From S.Godefroy's understanding from some of the Councillors is that the roads will likely not be closed due to emergency services • The BIA will learn more after the Region of Peel meeting happening today 	
2.	<p>Pilot Project for Downtown:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • S.Godefroy has been speaking with Erin from the Region of Peel about the report going to council now on June 10 with regards to all the safety and community concerns in the downtown core • Once the report is live, the BIA will be sharing with the Board of Directors and Safety and Beautification team • The BIA is looking to see what they are proposing for the downtown 	
3.	<p>Drop in Centre at Nelson:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • S.Godefroy had a meeting with Regeneration and the Region of Peel in the downtown core, with regards to the drop in Centre located at George and Nelson Street 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is staff with Regeneration assisting with other services at the drop in centre • Action: Have Regeneration and the Region of Peel do a presentation at the next Beautification & Safety meeting in June 	S.Godefroy
4.	<p>Interventions for Downtown:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • G. Comas and S.Godefroy have been working on a public parklette at 65 Queen St W • Receiving sponsorship from a downtown landlord • BIA has received quotes from Pop up Patio to install a temporary patio for the cost of \$10,800 • Received another quote from Holloway landscaping and their cost was \$15,000 to do a public parklette with rocks and decking • The BIA costs would be around \$5,800 and \$5,000 from the landlord • The landlord has also offered to install hoarding that the BIA could use to install the marketing campaigns • This space would be for a year • This relaxation station could be a place for families to come down and relax, and enjoy the downtown core • Action: Email the Board to get this approved before the next board meeting, to hopefully get the project installed before the end of June • Action: Need an agreement with the City of Brampton and the BIA to make sure the plants are installed and watered at this parklette • The BIA has also received quotes from pop up patio to do a patio on George St S, and enable the sidewalk to have an extended patio space • The cost is around \$32k from Pos Bueno to Vesuvio's • S.Godefroy has forward that quote to the City of Brampton • Action: Follow up from the City about this quote and idea • S.Godefroy also received a quote from the Pop up Patios to do a double patio on Queen St E similar to the patio in front of Segovia Coffee Co on Main St N • Received another quote from Queen St W near Baci Gifts/ Indian Curry Express, the quote for both patios would cost \$11k • Action: Follow up with the quotes since construction for watermain may be delayed till the fall • Recommend to go with patios on Queen St East and West as businesses on George St already have patios from last year • Action: Put together an executive summary of all the patios looking and the costs 	<p>S.Godefroy</p> <p>S.Godefroy</p> <p>S.Godefroy</p> <p>S.Godefroy</p> <p>S.Godefroy</p> <p>S.Godefroy</p>
